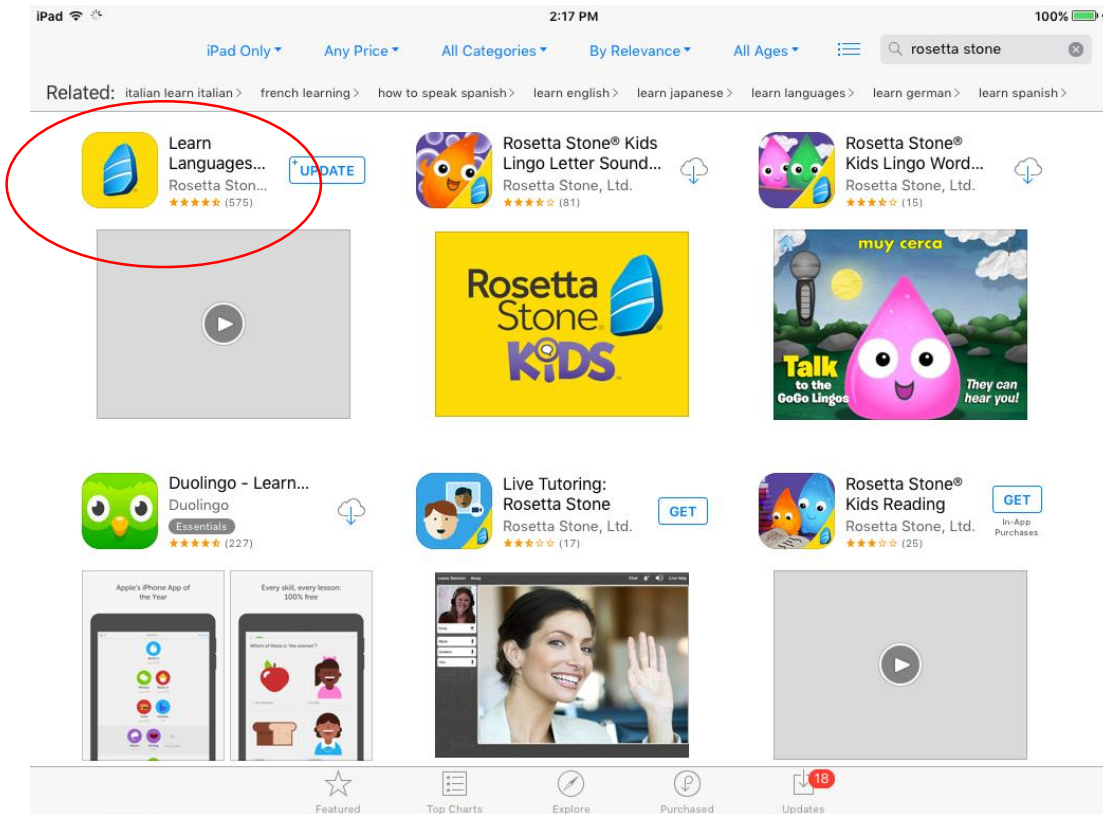
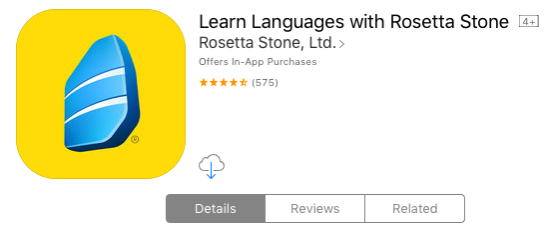


Installing the Rosetta Stone App – Apple Devices

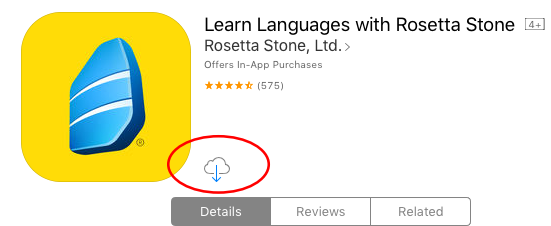
1. Before installing and using the Rosetta Stone App you need to log into Rosetta Stone through a computer. This will include Signing up for an account and selecting a language. Once you have done this you can move onto step 2.
2. Go to the Apple App store and search for Rosetta Stone.



3. Select the Rosetta Stone App, officially called the *Learn Languages: Rosetta Stone*.

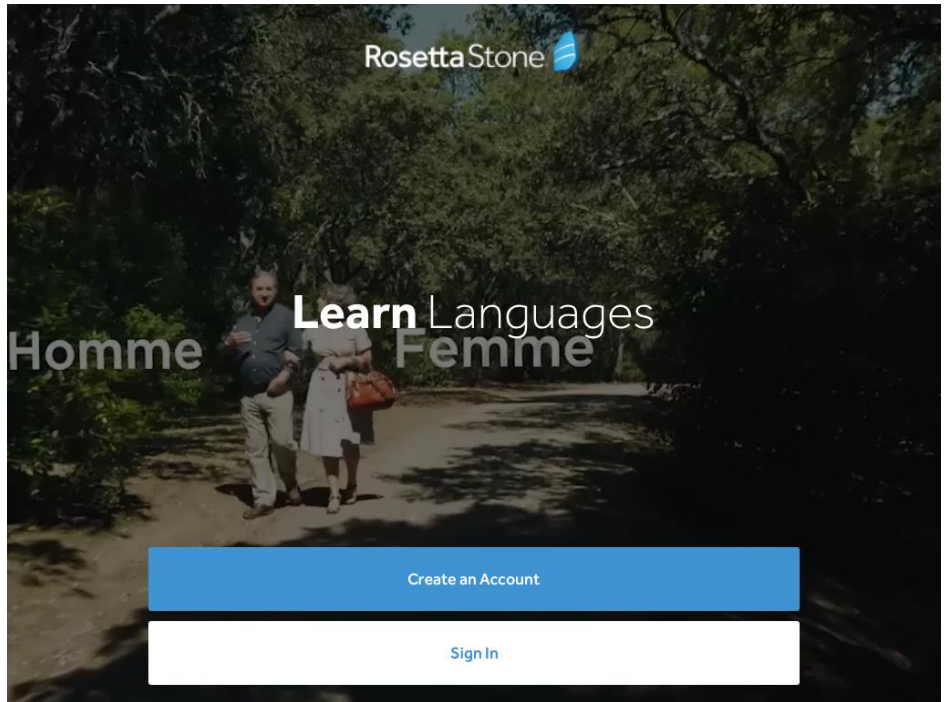


4. Install the app.

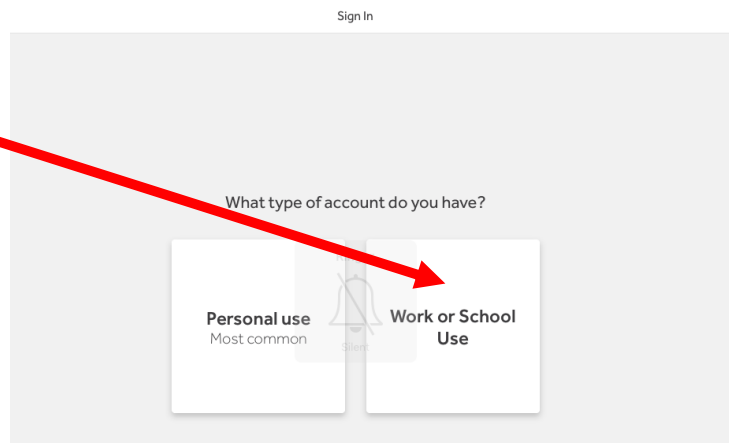


5. Open the App
6. Since you have already created an account in STEP 1 you can just sign in.



7. You get a screen asking, "What type of account do you have? You will want to select the **Work and School** option.



8. Enter the Username and Password for the account you created in STEP 1.

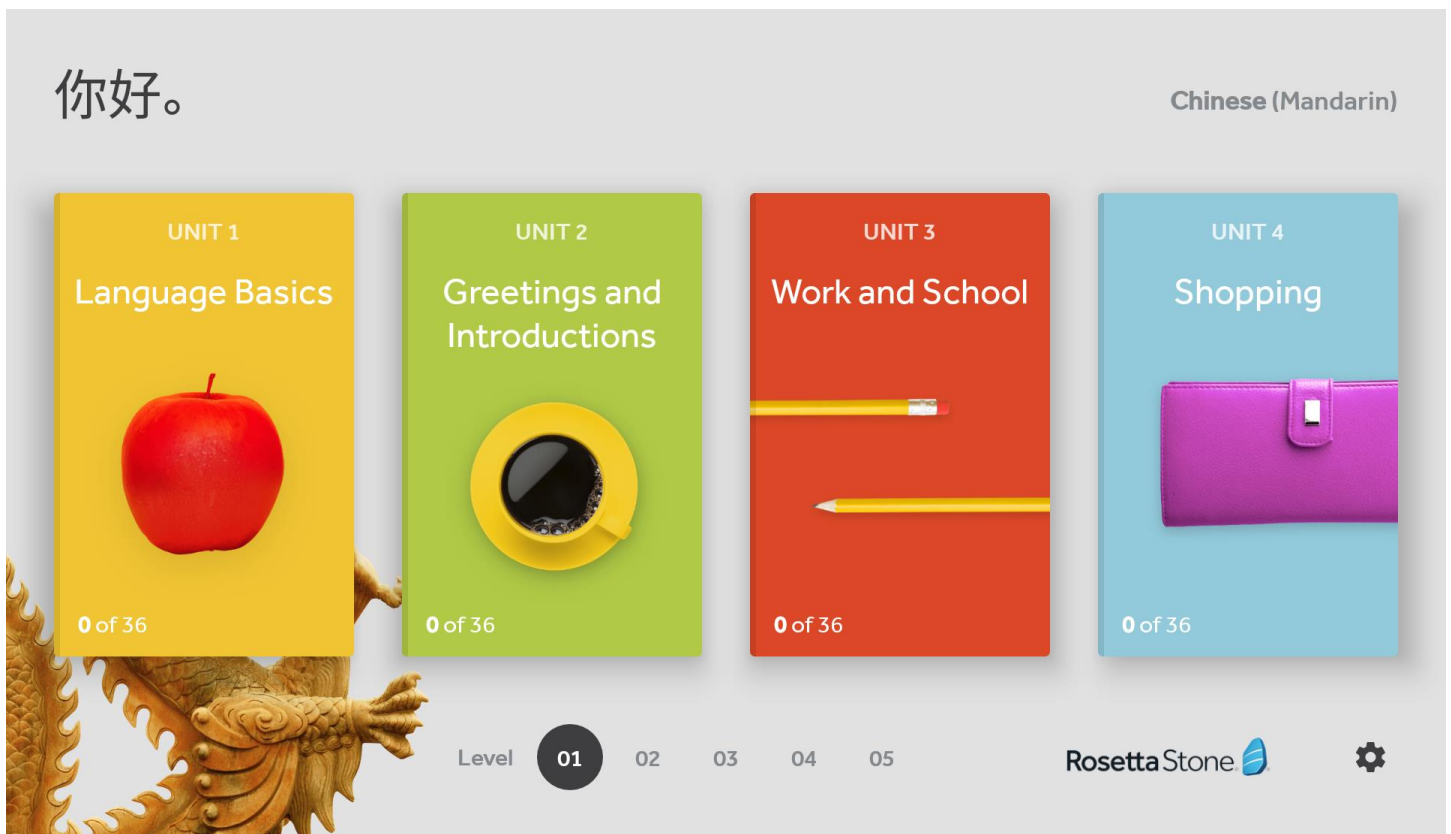

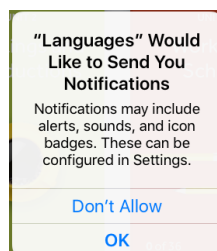
