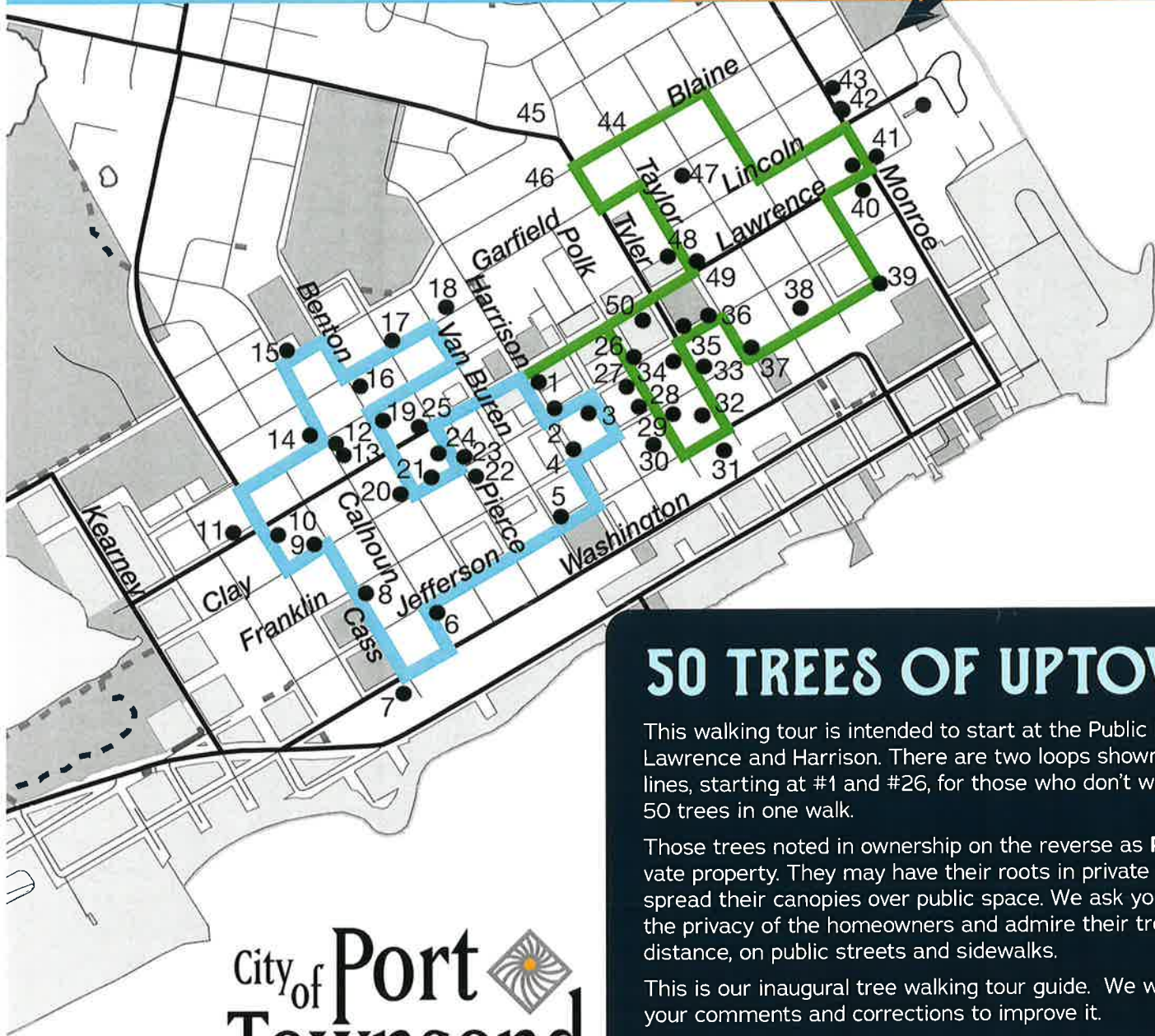

50 TREES OF UPTOWN



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This walking tour is intended to start at the Public Library at Lawrence and Harrison. There are two loops shown with colored lines, starting at #1 and #26, for those who don't wish to see all 50 trees in one walk.

Those trees noted in ownership on the reverse as **PP** are on private property. They may have their roots in private soil, but they spread their canopies over public space. We ask you to respect the privacy of the homeowners and admire their trees from a distance, on public streets and sidewalks.

This is our inaugural tree walking tour guide. We would welcome your comments and corrections to improve it.
