



## **Mill Road & Discovery Road Improvements**

The City of Port Townsend has contracted with Seton Construction, Inc. to perform roadway and drainage improvements on Mill Road and Discovery Road near the SR-20 intersection. Construction is scheduled to begin the week of January 19<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting.

This project includes drainage improvements and pavement rehabilitation to address localized roadway failures at this intersection.

### **Schedule:**

Construction hours anticipated to be 8:00AM-5:00PM, Monday through Friday

### **Mill Road**

Monday, January 19- Friday, January 23, 2026

Work will include:

- Mobilization and traffic control setup (Closure of Mill Rd)
- Roadway excavation, base preparation, and paving

**Mill Road will be completely closed to through traffic during work. Detours are shown on attached traffic control plan**

### **Discovery Road & South Discovery Road**

Beginning week of January 26, 2026 (*exact dates subject to progress and weather*)

Work will include:

- Mobilization and traffic control setup (Closure of Discovery Rd and S Discovery Rd)
- Drainage and roadway improvements
- Roadway excavation, base preparation, and paving

**Discovery Road will be completely closed to through traffic during work. Detours are shown on attached traffic control plan**

### **Traffic Impacts:**

- Temporary road closures, lane reductions, and signed detours will be in place
- **Mill Road will be closed to through traffic January 19–23**
- **Discovery Road and South Discovery Road will be detoured during subsequent phases**
- **The left-turn lane on SR-20 will be closed during construction**

Please refer to the **approved Traffic Control Plan** for detailed detour routes and traffic staging.

**Detour:**

Through traffic should avoid Mill Road and Discovery Road during the work period and use alternate routes. Detour routes will be clearly signed in advance of closures.

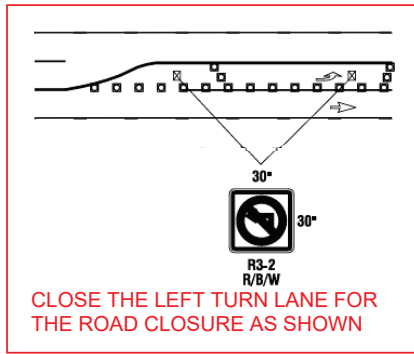
