

Homebound Service Criteria

The Port Townsend Public Library provides free home delivery service for city residents who are unable to visit the library due to age, disability, or illness. Caregivers are also eligible.

Library Courier delivers and picks up materials weekly at home and in care centers.

Library volunteers bring a variety of preselected materials to specific care centers on a rotating basis once per month.

Homebound patrons must meet at least one of these criteria:

- 1. Homebound (Requiring special assistance with transportation, such as paratransit)
- 2. Temporarily bedridden or recuperating from surgery or illness. (Eligibility is reassessed every three months.)

Please note that lack of transportation or residence in care center alone does not qualify an individual for Homebound Services.
