












# SHARING THE SPACE POLICY

The City of Port Townsend is dedicated to providing equitable access to and fair use of its public facilities in a comfortable and safe setting

	<p><b>CELL PHONES</b> Place your ringer on low or vibrate and answer phone calls outside to prevent the disturbance of others.</p>
	<p><b>CHILDREN</b> Children below the age of 9 must be accompanied and supervised at all times by someone age 13 or older.</p>
	<p><b>DISRUPTION</b> Avoid disruptive behavior that may reasonably result in the disturbance of others.</p>
	<p><b>PERSONAL HYGIENE</b> Shirts, shoes, and unintrusive personal hygiene are required.</p>
	<p><b>HARASSMENT &amp; ABUSE</b> Physical, sexual, verbal, or any other type of harassment or abuse of others is not allowed.</p>
	<p><b>DRUGS &amp; ALCOHOL</b> Illegal drug use, consumption, or possession is not allowed.</p>
	<p><b>SMOKING</b> Smoking, vaping, or other tobacco use is not allowed inside City facilities.</p>
	<p><b>FOOD &amp; DRINK</b> Persons with food or drinks are expected to clean up after themselves.</p>
	<p><b>PETS</b> We welcome service animals to accompany their owners during a visit. All animals must be on a leash. No animal may be left unattended.</p>
	<p><b>PERSONAL BELONGINGS</b> Personal belongings must remain within the visitor's personal space and not be left unattended.</p>
	<p><b>Visitors violating these rules may be asked to leave and may be trespassed by the police</b></p>
