

SHARING THE SPACE POLICY

The City of Port Townsend is dedicated to providing equitable access to and fair use of its public facilities in a comfortable and safe setting

□ ≤ 1	CELL PHONES Place your ringer on low or vibrate and answer phone calls
	outside to prevent the disturbance of others.
	CHILDREN Children below the age of 9 must be accompanied and supervised at all times by someone age 13 or older.
	DISRUPTION Avoid disruptive behavior that may reasonably result in the disturbance of others.
	PERSONAL HYGIENE Shirts, shoes, and unintrusive personal hygiene are required.
STOP	HARASSMENT & ABUSE Physical, sexual, verbal, or any other type of harassment or abuse of others is not allowed.
	DRUGS & ALCOHOL Illegal drug use, consumption, or possession is not allowed.
	SMOKING Smoking, vaping, or other tobacco use is not allowed inside City facilities.
	FOOD & DRINK Persons with food or drinks are expected to clean up after themselves.
	PETS We welcome service animals to accompany their owners during a visit. All animals must be on a leash. No animal may be left unattended.
	PERSONAL BELONGINGS Personal belongings must remain within the visitor's personal space and not be left unattended.
	Visitors violating these rules may be asked to leave and may be trespassed by the police

These rules apply to the following City locations when open to the public: The Carnegie Library, Charles Pink House, City Hall, Cotton Building,

Mountain View Commons, Pope Marine Building, & Public Restrooms
